

## Minot Kiwanis To Hear Talk By Egyptian

Minot Kiwanians at their noon meeting next Tuesday will be told a story about the Aswan High Dam in Egypt and problems of development in that country.

The speaker will be 33-year-old Ahmed M. Talaat, deputy director for public relations of the Egyptian High Dam ministry.

Talaat is a participant in the international visitor program, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, U. S. State Department, and will come to Minot from Riverdale, where he will inspect Garrison dam.

The Aswan dam will be the largest rockfill dam in the world in size, storage capacity and electric production.

Talaat has been in the United States since February and has been visiting dams in various parts of the nation.

G. C. Monson, president of Minot Kiwanis Club, said arrangements for the appearance of Talaat in Minot were made with the cooperation of Sen. Milton R. Young, R-N. D., and the Corps of Engineers at Riverdale.
